TAPPING INTO HOLY GHOST POWER

What does a Spirit-filled "power injection" look like in 2025? For me, it isn't always spectacular or dramatic—it's daily grace. It's the unseen strength to continue doing what the Lord has given me to do.

YOUTUBE IS A VERB. WHO KNEW?

What kind of fool would build up a collection of over 300 videos for ministry over five years... and then leave it all to start a new channel? I would. I did!

For half a decade I worked hard creating, posting, preparing, and producing videos: songs the Lord gave me, devotionals I wrote, even full book studies from Scripture. Yet I realized along the way that YouTube has its own language, its own "algorithm," and I wasn't speaking it very well.

So I started fresh. Not to erase the past, but to sharpen the focus. The new channel is simple: just me, the Scriptures, and my viewers. Intimate. Real. Pastor-to-flock.

And yes, I now say it this way: I YouTube. A verb! But I YouTube with a bit more wisdom, and with a heart set on connection rather than numbers. The early signs are encouraging—and I believe the Lord is breathing on this new chapter.

WALKING WITH JESUS CLOSER

I've been experimenting with what it looks like to include Jesus in every single moment of my day. It's not easy! But it's transformative.

When I wake, I whisper, "Good morning, Lord." When I'm driving, I invite Him into the quiet. When I'm in conversation, I ask silently for His wisdom. Even in the most ordinary routines, I'm learning to acknowledge His presence.

The Bible says:

"In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths."

— Proverbs 3:6 (KJV)

It takes practice, but when we include Jesus moment by moment, we discover He is closer than we realized. The Shepherd really does walk with His sheep. And in a noisy, divided world, His nearness is our peace.

Try it for a day: keep company with Jesus. You may find that the most common minutes become holy ground.
